

THE 3 STEPS TO EXPERT DIVOT REPAIR

Repairing divots expertly is a golfing skill that can be quickly and easily learned by ALL golfers ...

You need 4 ingredients to get it right...

An iron club (wood heads are not suitable)
Some sand suitable for filling divots
About 20 seconds
A desire to leave the divot expertly repaired

The 3 steps the expert takes to fix a divot go like this:

1. Take an iron club, and with its leading edge, sharply “cut” the surrounding grass back into the centre of the divot. Start the “cut” about 1” to 2” around the perimeter of the divot. With a little bit of practice, this takes literally, only seconds to get a workable amount of grass “cut” back into the core of the divot. This action will minimise the “crater” caused by the divot and allows the grass to cover the impacted area much, much more rapidly.
2. Once the grass has been cut back in, tip a small amount of sand into the repaired area – just enough to cover the surface and filter to the base of the repaired area AND a little bit extra on top.
3. With the foot, tamp down that sand so that the surface matches the surrounding area and congratulate yourself on a job well done!

Do this each and every time, and you become a “Scratch” marker in the divot repair department!



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
