Membership FAQ's

What is the difference between Full & Restricted membership?

A Full member can play at any time on any of our courses except during single (opposite) sex competitions.

A Restricted member can play at any time except Saturday and during single (opposite) sex competition.

Is there a Family discount?

We offer a discount of 33% off the Entrance Fee for the immediate family of Full, Restricted or Country members.

Is there a discount if a husband & wife, father & children etc join together?

Yes, the **33% family discount** applies to all but the first entrance fee.

What incentive does the Club offer if I propose a new member to the Club?

The club is actively encouraging existing members to introduce new members to the Club. Any member who introduces a new Full, Restricted or Country member to the club will receive as a credit on their next subscription **20%** of the value of the new subscription (less the GST)

How do I join the Club and do I need to be nominated?

All applications for membership require a Proposer and a Secunder who are members of the club over the age of 18 years.

The club recognises however that this may not always be possible and **our membership will open on two occasions during the year for applicants who are not nominated.** If you would like to be contacted prior to membership opening please email c.kluge@indooroopillygolf.com.au

Can I pay my subscriptions every 6 months?

Yes, subscriptions can be paid every 6 months. A 7.5% administration fee is charged for this convenience.

I'm not playing much anymore but I may want to play in the future. What are my options?

The Leave of absence category is available to those members who want to put their playing rights on hold. The Club charges an annual fee that gives the member the right to return to a playing category any time in the future.

Whilst a leave of absence member can I play golf?

Leave of absence members can play golf socially or as a member's guest in a competition. Play in a competition is allowed up to 6 times per year; social golf is unlimited. The current members' guest fee is payable for each round of golf which can be charged to your member account if you wish.

Leave of absence members can also purchase Temporary Playing Rights in their old playing category in blocks of 4 weeks and up to 3 times a year. The pro rata amount of the annual subscription is payable for this access.

If I resign from the Club but want to rejoin later, do I pay another entrance fee?

The current policy is that a member who has resigned from the club and later wants to rejoin, pays **the lesser** of the current entrance fee or the current Leave of absence subscription multiplied by the number of years since resignation.

Why do golf clubs have an entrance fee?

All golf clubs are not for profit organisations. The annual subscription contributes to the operating costs of the Club, but any capital improvements to the golf course or clubhouse are funded by entrance fees.
