ACTIVITIES TO ENHANCE YOUR DAY

We can organise competition holes such as nearest the pins, longest drives and straight drives which add to the atmosphere and excitement of your golf day.

Another fun activity is the fastest drive which involves a police radar set on a hole with each player asked for a small donation as they pass the hole. Each player's driver speed is recorded and notices are handed out for infringements such as "murdering the game of golf" and "dangerous driving".



Putting competitions are also an easy way to create a bit of fun and enhance the competitive atmosphere. During registration have your guests play a simple or more strategic competition to practice their putting before tee off.

Golf clinics can be arranged through our golf shop. One of our fully trained PGA Golf Professionals can conduct lessons prior to play, be placed on a "beat the pro hole" or join one of your groups. Speak with your coordinator for more details and prices.



CARBON OFFSET PROGRAM

IGC is in a unique position to create and manage a local carbon offset program. We are a keen supporter of the environment and are actively involved in making a significant contribution to assisting and improving our local environment for our members and the local community.

In 2006 the Club commissioned a Landscape Master plan and has committed to a 5 year implementation program that will see a further 20,000 trees planted on the property. We're also committed to reducing our town water consumption which we have reduced by 65%, saving 44,000L per day. We also use 300 million litres of treated effluent water per year .

In 2007 we commenced a tree planting program, planting 2000 trees. 676 of these trees is sufficient to offset the carbon emissions of the course maintenance equipment fleet. Listed below is a way you can contribute to our local carbon offset program and make your event at IGC carbon neutral.

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DRESS REGULATIONS

Dress regulations apply immediately upon entry to the Indooroopilly Golf Club and pertain to all areas of the club property practice areas, car parks, golf shop, clubhouse surrounds and on the golf course.

Fashion evolution makes absolute guidelines impossible, but the unchanging consideration is that the standard of dress on the course or in the clubhouse should reflect the status and dignity of the Indooroopilly Golf Club.

GENTLEMEN

The following dress attire is acceptable:

Shirts must have a collar and are to be worn in the waistband unless the shirt is tailored and fitted for wear outside the shorts/slacks.

Tailored slacks or shorts.

Short, predominantly white socks worn above the ankle.

Golf shoes fitted with soft spikes only (no metal spikes) which must be worn with socks.

Enclosed shoes without socks are acceptable in and around the Clubhouse and car park before and after golf.

The following dress attire is not acceptable:

Beach attire, football clothes and socks.

Shorts with drawstring waist, t-shirts, singlet tops or shirts that do not cover the shoulders.

Any type of open shoe eg. thongs or sandals

Clothes that are not maintained in good condition.

LADIES

The following dress attire is acceptable:

Shirts must be collared and worn inside the waistband unless the shirt is tailored and fitted for wear outside the shorts/slacks.

Tailored slacks, skirts, divided skirts or shorts of suitable length (no more than 15cm above the knee) worn with short or knee length socks.

The following dress attire is not acceptable:

Beach attire, thongs, singlet tops or shirts that do not cover the shoulders.

PLEASE MAKE SURE YOUR GUESTS ARE AWARE OF THESE REGULATIONS PRIOR TO PLAY.



RESPONSIBLE SERVICE OF ALCOHOL

Indooroopilly Golf Club practices Responsible Service of Alcohol. The Club is responsible to ensure alcohol is served responsibly and a range of non alcoholic beverages are available at all times. Indooroopilly Golf Club ensures safe transport arrangements are in place for all patrons upon departure of a function.

Liquor cannot be supplied to:

Minors

Unduly intoxicated persons

Disorderly patrons

Golf Days – On Course Policies

1. Only mid strength or light beer will be served on the golf course.
2. Club management must brief all persons who are dispensing alcohol on course prior to tee off.
3. Club management must brief all guests about their duty of care to themselves and others whilst consuming alcohol.
4. Any sponsored alcohol provided for taste testing at a golf day must be limited to one standard drink per person for the entire event.

SMOKING POLICIES

- All outdoor areas that serve food & beverage are no smoking areas and smoking is not permitted for any reason.
- The golf course is also a licensed area and only holes 3, 5, 7 & 9 on each nine are permitted for smoking.
- There are Designated Outdoor Smoking Areas (DOSA) allocated for all Function Rooms, guests will be directed to these areas by staff.
- Smoking is permitted in areas where food & beverage are not served or consumed.
- Food cannot be taken into or consumed in a DOSA.
- Drinks can be consumed in the DOSA.
- No service can be provided for drinks service in the DOSA.
- Only clearing of glasses and ash trays is permitted by staff in the DOSA.
- No entertainment is to be provided to patrons in the DOSA .



TERMS AND CONDITIONS

BOOKING AND CANCELLATION POLICIES

Deposits

30 or more players—50% of the green fee

Less than 30 players—100% of the anticipated green fee

Payments

For all golf days where the client is represented by a third party, prepayment of the balance of the green fees, cart hire and food and beverage is required prior to the event. For all other golf days you will be invoiced after the event. The final invoice will be issued on a strict 7 day account.

Cancellations

In the instance that a golf event is cancelled the following penalties will apply:

Within 60 days of the event—no refund of deposit.

61 or more days notice—50% refund if the room is re-sold to the satisfaction of IGC.

Postponements

In the event that the golf day is postponed the following penalties will apply:

Within 60 days of the event—the deposit will not be refunded or transferred.

61 or more days notice—the deposit will be transferred to the new date.

Friday cancellations

In the instance that the event is scheduled for a Friday and is subsequently cancelled the following penalties will apply:

Within 90 days of the event—no refund of the deposit.

91 days or more days notice—50% refund if the room is re-sold to the satisfaction of IGC.

Friday postponements

In the instance that the event is scheduled for a Friday and is subsequently postponed the following penalties will apply:

Within 90 days of the event—no refund of the deposit.

91 days or more days notice—50% refund if the room is re-sold to the satisfaction of IGC.

Cancellations and postponements due to weather conditions

Cancellations due to unsuitable course conditions will be at the sole discretion of IGC. In the event of wet weather conditions the course superintendent will evaluate the course the morning of the event and decide on cart usage for the day. If carts are deemed unsuitable for use on the day clients will be able to walk with pull buggies.

If the course is closed by IGC prior to the commencement of the day all efforts will be made to make an alternative date for rescheduling. If this is not possible the deposit will be refunded to the client. If the course is deemed available to play but the client decides not to proceed the client is liable for all green fees, cart hire fees and catering costs if they choose to cancel the event. Exemptions to this policy are at the discretion of the sales coordinator—requests for exemption must be received in writing.

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Dress Regulations will apply at the Club as per the attached dress regulations policy. Please make sure your guests are aware of these regulations prior to play.

COURSE FEES

Starting format and course to be played is at the discretion of Indooroopilly Golf Club. If exclusive use of the course is required then a shotgun green fee is applicable. Mini shotgun start attracts a \$250 fee per group of 4 and a 1 tee start (4—50 players) incur a green fee of \$50.00.

The full shotgun green fee will include Indooroopilly Golf Club operational staff to assist, direct and brief players, the establishment of a separate registration area, placement and retrieval of on course minor competition markers such as nearest the pin (ntp), provision of score cards, a players information note detailing the days competition and activities and access to the showers. A compiler of the scorecards and results is available at \$120.00. This must be pre-arranged with your sales coordinator.

CATERING REQUIREMENTS

Menu requirements for pre-golf, on course and at presentations after golf are required 14 days prior to your golf day. Final numbers for catering must be advised 3 days prior to the event.

SIGNAGE/MARQUEES

IGC staff is responsible for all on-course set up. With any full course booking we will set up 9 on-course items (i.e. signs/promotional vehicles/table, umbrella and chair) which will be situated in various locations free of charge. Any additional on course items (maximum of 18 items) will be at a cost of \$300.00. NB - signage opportunities are available to smaller groups - please speak with the golf coordinator about your requirements.

Under no circumstances will banners be hung on external balconies. Clubhouse signage is restricted to registration area and your assigned function room. Large on-course items (eg. Marquees) are by negotiation and charges may apply. All movement of larger equipment on course must be under IGC staff supervision.

All banners/promotional materials will be available the next working day for courier pick up unless other arrangements have been made with us.

DAMAGE

The client is responsible for any damage to IGC property.

The Club will take all necessary care but can not accept responsibility for damage or loss of any gifts or other possessions left on the Club premises before, during or after an event. Responsibility for arranging any insurances lies with the client. Any function the Club deems necessary may be subject to a \$180.00 security fee.

MOTORISED CARTS

Indooroopilly Golf Club has 60 motorised carts for hire at \$40.00 per cart. We can hire additional carts for the day which is priced on application (includes transport costs). All motorised golf carts used on course must be provided by IGC and their use is dependant on course conditions on the day. Carts must be booked prior to the event and the use of carts is at the complete discretion of IGC. An IGC staff member will drive all hospitality carts unless prior arrangements are made with the sales coordinator.



BEVERAGES

Sponsorship of beverages is solely at the Club's discretion. IGC has supply contracts with the Fosters group and Cadbury Schweppes and these products are used exclusively for all events.

If a client has sponsored beer or wine the following conditions apply:

The clients account will be credited the wholesale value of the product supplied (beer only) and the normal retail price will be charged for the number of items consumed. Wine will be charged at a \$15.00 per bottle corkage fee.

It is the Club's responsibility to enforce the responsible service of alcohol legislation. Service of alcohol will be refused to any patron who demonstrates they have consumed excess alcohol. On course eskies will only be filled with light beers.

STAFFING REQUIREMENTS

IGC staff will serve food and beverages at registration, on drinks carts and at after golf functions. Staff are also available to erect banners up to the specified number of banners allowed for each event. Additional staff, if required (for example on course sausage sizzle and other additional services throughout the day), for the preparation of the day will be charged at \$25.00 per hour.

FIRE SAFETY

Fire safety laws prohibit the use of heaters, heat producing devices, open flames, lamps, lanterns and pyrotechnic displays inside the building and only permits their use outside under strict supervision. Permission must be sought from the Club's insurers.

COURSE RENOVATIONS

Minor course renovations, temporary tees and greens are considered a necessary part of course management. These scenarios are avoided where possible but will not attract lower green fees as a result. Major course renovations will have at least a 2 week recovery time after renovations and the course is then deemed suitable for play.
