Ladies Golf Trip: is being fine tuned. There is a flyer available which outlines the details and dates for payments. There are now 58 ladies on tour. Par 3s:

As of July 1 IGC will implement the Call up Hole Procedure; All players are to follow the call-up hole procedure on ALL Par 3's:

1. If there is a group waiting on the tee of a Par 3 (“2nd group”), the group in front (“1st group”) **must** initiate a call-up procedure. (this is not optional)
2. Once the 1st group's balls are on the Par 3's green, those balls will be marked and lifted by the players in the 1st group. Those players will then step aside to the designated signed area at the back of the green.
3. The 1st group will then indicate, by way of an arm wave, to the group behind (the 2nd group), to commence hitting their tee shots to the green.
4. Players in the 2nd group behind WILL NOT hit up without clearly being called up by the 1st group on the green.

5. If any ball from the 2nd group interferes with the play of a ball belonging to the 1st group, a player in the 1st group may mark and lift the ball as required and will replace the ball belonging to the 2nd group to its original place before leaving the green.
6. Once the 2nd group have hit up and completed their tee shots, the 1st group will promptly putt out and briskly move to the next tee.
7. Once all balls for the 2nd group are on the putting green, they will be marked and lifted and the Call Up process (see 2-6 above) starts again.

If at any time the group "behind" is not in a position to play their tee shots on the Par 3 in play, (for example, due to a lost ball or due to being "out of position" in the field) the 1st group on the putting green should simply complete the hole without delay. If the 2nd group subsequently appear on the tee, and if the 1st group has started to putt out, the 1st group will have "right of way", will not call up, and will promptly putt out and briskly move to the next tee.

- **Pace of Play:**

Keep up with the group in front:

if you have lost a fairway 2 players putt out then move quickly to next tee;

Fourball: if you can't beat your partner's score pick up;

On Going To the ball

This should take 40 sec:

Sight

Measure

Practice swing

Hit

"Remember that your position on the golf course is directly behind the group in front of you, not in front of the groups behind you."

- **Conditions of Play** outline a criteria to meet if the lady member wants to play in a particular event. They apply to **Honour Board and Special events** and are attached to the timesheet with a lower case 'i' for information, COP s are then pinned up on the **Noticeboard in Locker Room** and in window near the registration window.
- **For Team Events:** there is **no 'i' in team** therefore if a lady player has to withdraw from Team event that player **must find** a replacement and inform the Captain.
- **Security:** Please be mindful of your bags when not in attendance.
- **Tip:** When spanning your ball on the green turn **it upside down**. This is a reminder to **span back to original position** when you go to replace your ball!
- **Definitions of different golf games can be found in the Fixture Book on page 11.**
- **Check local rules on the whiteboard next to the window. Take a photo as a reminder out on the course.**
- **No NTPs when playing in the 9 Hole competition;**
- **Please do not park buggies/carts in front of the green**, eg Gold 6 if buggies are left of the path, this prevents the group behind from hitting their 2nd shot thus affecting pace of play. Park carts on the designated path and buggies up under the tree. However, please use common sense, if a group is close behind don't cut across to your buggy because again that will affect their 2nd shot and pace of play while waiting for you to get out of the way. If you have parked buggy up under the tree leave the green at the back and walk the path to your buggy.

- **Submitting Scorecards:** If you change your score on the computer, even if you press 'Confirm' you **must rescan** your card so that the new data is saved. Think of the card area as the Score Card tent like the majors.
- **Timesheet access:** The Staff in the Pro Shop has been instructed, for years now, not to put members down on a closed timesheet. It puts them in a very awkward position with the members. In fairness to all lady members the timesheet for a special event opens 15 days prior unless a specific request is made to the Lady Captain who may, at her discretion, book the group in early.
