



**Black Tea-tree** (*Melaleuca bracteata*) An old Black Tea-tree growing along the riverbank on Blue 3 with a close-up of flowers below.







**Broad-leaved Apple** (*Angophora subvelutina*) A solitary specimen of Broad-leaved Apple grows on the riverbank on Gold 3 with a close-up of the bark below.







**Brush Ironbark** (*Bridelia exaltata*) The Brush Ironbark grows along the Brisbane River on the LHS of Gold 3, where it is represented by a mature specimen and several saplings.







**Cottonwood** (*Hibiscus tiliaceus*) A natural hedge of Cottonwoods grows along the riverbank on Red 4 with a close-up of the flowers shown below.







**Grey Mangrove** (*Avicennia marina*) A view towards IGC (around Red 5) from the river during high tide, showing the Grey Mangrove forest in front of a scattered row of Queensland Blue Gums on top of the river banks, above the tidal range. A close-up of aerial roots (pneumatophores) & seedlings is provided below.







**Macaranga** (*Macaranga tanarius*) Macaranga is a pioneer tree with glossy heart-shaped leaves, growing along the riverbank on Red 6, with flower close-up below.







**Milky Mangrove** (*Excoecaria agallocha*) This tree is growing in the tidal range on the RHS of Blue 3 fairway, with close-up of flowers below.







**Queensland Blue Gum** (*Eucalyptus tereticornis*) A line of Queensland Blue Gums along the riverbank on Gold 3 with a close-up of flowers below.







**Red Mangrove** (*Rhizophora stylosa*) The red mangrove is easily recognised by the looping stilted roots. This species is rarely seen along the Brisbane River and this specimen is growing on the RHS of the Blue 3 fairway.





**River Mangrove** (*Aegiceras corniculatum*) This small tree is growing in the tidal range on the RHS of Blue 3 fairway, flowering in late Winter-Spring, with close-up below.







**Soapwood** (*Alphitonia excelsa*) Soapwood is a common small pioneer tree growing along the riverbank on LHS Gold 6 green & Red 4 tee-block. Below are close-ups of flowers and pale underside of leaves.
