**Events to be contested** (1 round stroke play (gross) qualifying  $\rightarrow$  match play):

Members wishing to enter the tournament **must** fill out the online entry form via the email link sent to you or via the post online, or fill out a paper version in the Golf Shop and put it into the entry box in the Golf Shop no later than <u>6:00pm on</u> <u>Wednesday 19 February 2025</u>.

IMPORTANT: If you want to play in either the Junior, Senior or Veterans, you MUST select this on the entry form and you are then not eligible for any other grades. (If selecting this, your age is determined on the qualifying round Saturday 1 March).

#### All Grades and Age categories will be determined on the qualifying round Saturday 1 March.

In the qualifying round you will be drawn in the grade or age category you have selected or eligible for (or close too).

Events will be distributed across the 2 courses on the day with Age categories on one course and Grades on the other. Golf operations will do this after entries close with no changes permitted once completed.

NO late entries will be accepted\*

### **Tournament format**

- One round qualifying of gross stroke play on the course you are drawn on, played on Saturday 1 March off the <u>blue tees</u>.
- All competitors in the same grade or age category will play the same course.
- The top 32 to qualify in Championship grade, A grade, B grade, C grade.
- The top 8 to qualify for Juniors, Seniors and Veterans (You must select this on entry form to be eligible and then you are not eligible for the grades above)
- Positions/ranking in the match play draws will be decided by count back based on the gross scores.

### Entry details

- Entries will be collated by Golf Operations after entries close:
  - Entrants will be assigned to a tee-off time by Golf Operations for the qualifying round. Entry fee will be the normal \$10 competition fee for the qualifying round (plus guest green fee as applicable for certain membership categories).
  - Entrants will be grouped into AM and PM fields. If possible, entrants will be assigned to AM or PM fields in accordance with the preference indicated on their entry form, but this will depend on the number of entries and cannot be guaranteed.
  - If entries exceed capacity, the higher GA handicaps in each grade or age category at the time entries close, will be balloted out and will be put on a reserve list.
  - The time sheets for Saturday 1 March (Monthly medal) will open as per normal at 6:00am eight days in advance for Members <u>who are not</u> entering the Club Matchplay Championships. Members can book online in the normal manner, using any possible vacant AM/PM spots on the booking sheet for these days.

### **Eligibility**

A member's membership category must include eligibility to play in Club Matchplay Championships (Honour Board Events) and you must be available for all dates. To be eligible to qualify for any of the events, members must have a minimum of 20 legitimate scorecard entries in their Golf Link record and their handicap must not be designated as "Provisional".

#### Withdrawals from match play

Once the match play draw has been determined it is not expected there will be any withdrawals. However, it can happen that a member who has qualified is unable to play for health, injury or other legitimate/acceptable reasons.

The following protocols will apply in the event of a withdrawal:

<u>Withdrawal before 1<sup>st</sup></u> round of match play	Players ranked 33 <sup>rd</sup> , 34 <sup>th</sup> and 35 <sup>th</sup> in each grade (Championship, A, B and C) at the end of the qualifying round will be designated as "reserves". Players ranked 9 <sup>th</sup> , 10 <sup>th</sup> and 11 <sup>th</sup> in each Age category (Jnr, Snr and Vets) at the end of the qualifying round will be designated as "reserves".
	If a player qualifies and then withdraws before the first round of match play, Golf Operations will take reasonable steps to contact the best-ranked reserve for that grade/age category and offer that person the vacated spot without otherwise adjusting the draws.
	The first person offered who confirms acceptance will be given the spot.
	As there will be no adjustment of the draw, this means that a person ranked 33 <sup>rd</sup> or 34 <sup>th</sup> could end up filling the #1 seed position for that grade.
<u>Withdrawal after 1<sup>st</sup> round of match play</u>	The best-ranked loser from the just-completed round of that match play draw will be offered the spot.
	Golf Operations will take reasonable steps to contact the best-ranked loser and offer that person the vacated spot. The first person offered who confirms acceptance will be given the spot.
	This means that someone who moves to the next round could end up playing the person they defeated in a previous round.
