## **Honour Board Event**

### Saturday 1 March to Sunday 16 March

- Stroke Qualifying round 2 options
  - o opt 1 Saturday 1 March or
  - o **opt 2** Tuesday 4 March
- Quarter Finals Match Play Sunday 9 March
- **Semi Finals Match Play** Saturday 15 March
- **Finals Day Match Play** Sunday 16 March (36 holes for Championship Grade players only. All other grades are 18 holes)

#### **Members wishing to qualify must:**

Members wishing to enter the tournament **must** fill out the online entry form via the email link sent to you or via the post online, or fill out a paper version in the Golf Shop and put it into the entry box in the Golf Shop no later than <u>6:00pm on Wednesday 19 February 2025</u>

# This year players will have the option of choosing what day they play their qualifying round.

Players must nominate on the entry form whether they want to play on either the Saturday or Tuesday for their qualifying round. (Saturday 1 March or Tuesday 4 March).

If you choose a day your membership category does not allow access, you are still able to play, however you do pay the guest green fee. (example if you are restricted member and nominate Saturday, you pay the guest fee for out of category game)

There will be no extra guest fees for days played on the match play rounds though, if you qualify.

All match play rounds are played on the weekend

Golf Operations will enter all players for the qualifying round after entries close. Players will be drawn with similar handicapped players, with changes not permitted without Golf Operations consent.



Your grade will be determined on your qualifying round day.

In the qualifying round you will be drawn in the grade you are eligible for by Golf operations after entries close.

#### **Events to be contested by your GA handicap**

(1 round stroke play (gross) qualifying → match play):

Event	GA handicap eligibility (on your first round )	No. to qualify for match play
Championship grade	10.9 and under	8
A grade	11.0 to 20	8
B-grade	20.1 to 30	8
C-grade	30.1 and above	8

#### **Tournament format**

- One round qualifying of gross stroke play played on either Saturday 1 March or Tuesday 4 March.
- The top 8 to qualify in the Championship grade, A grade, B-grade and C-grade.
- Positions/ranking in the match play draws will be decided by count back based on the gross scores.

#### **Eligibility**

A member's membership category must include eligibility to play in Club Matchplay Championships (Honour Board Events) and you must be available for all dates. To be eligible to qualify for any of the events, members must have a minimum of 20 legitimate scorecard entries in their Golf Link record and their handicap must not be designated as "Provisional". #### Withdrawals from match play

Once the match play draw has been determined it is not expected there will be any withdrawals. However, it can happen that a member who has qualified is unable to play for health, injury or other legitimate/acceptable reasons.

The following protocols will apply in the event of a withdrawal:

# Withdrawal before 1st round of match play

If a player who qualified for the matchplay withdraws before the first round of match play, Golf Operations will take reasonable steps to contact the best-ranked reserve and offer that person the vacated spot without otherwise adjusting the draws.

The first person offered who confirms acceptance will be given the spot.

As there will be no adjustment of the draw, the person ranked 9<sup>th</sup> 10<sup>th</sup> or 11<sup>th</sup> could end up filling the #1 seed position in the primary event for that grade.

# Withdrawal after 1st round of match play

The best-ranked loser from the just-completed round of that match play draw will be offered the spot.

Golf Operations will take reasonable steps to contact the best-ranked loser and offer that person the vacated spot. The first person offered who confirms acceptance will be given the spot.

This means that someone who moves to the next round could end up playing the person they defeated in a previous round.
