RAMSEY CUP SENIOR MEN'S MID-WEEK CHALLENGE



The Ramsey Cup is an Indooroopilly Golf Club challenge within a Golf Australia event, the Queensland Men's Senior Mid-Week Teams Challenge, which commenced in 2007. All major golf clubs within the region triangulated by Bribie Island Golf, Toowoomba and Coolangatta Golf Clubs (i.e. the triangle of South East Qld) are invited to participate.

Approximately 20 Clubs are part of this major annual event with IGC sponsoring two teams as the Club has two 18-hole golf courses.

While on the board of Golf Australia, Ian Read was a key person in establishing the event. Ian Bishop took over captaining Indooroopilly from Ian Read, Frank Ramsey took on the role 2013 and then Tony Rees in 2021. In 2025 co-captains of Indooroopilly Teams are Steve Hanson and Don Murray.

The event is a round robin between teams of the participating clubs generally held between April and August. It is a team match-play home and away over 18-holes with teams of eight players aged 55 years of age or older with a minimum of two members over 60 years of age. Four play singles matches off the stick and four play in two fourball teams with handicaps.

The main trophy is donated by Golf Australia and our team has won at least twice since inception.

The Ramsey Cup event is separate from the Golf Australia trophy. As we sponsor two teams, when Frank Ramsey was Captain of Indooroopilly Senior Men's Challenge Teams he introduced a separate competition between the two Indooroopilly teams. Following the conclusion of the Golf Australia event, our teams play against each other. As a reward to the winning team, Frank donated a replica cup of the British Golf Open, the Claret Jug, for the annual event. This cup was named after Frank by past Indooroopilly Captain, Jim Ross.

CLAIMING CUP



The Claming Cup is a team event between Indooroopilly and Brisbane Golf Clubs played annually at the alternate club. It became an official competition for the above pewter cup in 1967 after being a social event between members of both clubs, played on the Gold Coast during the January school holidays in the early 1960's. The Cup is held in the loser's clubhouse for the ensuing 12 months when any member from the winning side can claim that it should be filled for their pleasure.

THE CHALLENGE CUP – IGC V PYMBLE

For annual competition between Indooroopilly and our reciprocal club Pymble Golf Club in NSW. Inaugurated in 1981.

HIT UP CUP

The Claiming Cup with the Brisbane Golf Club was originally played as a social event between holidaying Indooroopilly and Brisbane Golf Club members at Southport in the early 1960's. In 2015 Club member, Nic Hawkins, donated the Hit Up Cup for annual competition between members from Indooroopilly and our reciprocal club, Southport Golf Club. The Cup is held in the loser's clubhouse for the following 12 months when any member of the winning side can "hit them up" for a drink.

LONG POCKET CUP

Cup donated by Eve Stephen (Women's President 1963-65). The event was originally an honour board team event competed for at the new Long Pocket complex, commencing in 1966. A decline in the popularity of the event resulted in the removal of its honour board status from 2009. However, teams still compete for the perpetual trophy.



JUBILEE TROPHY

Original Plate donated in 1976 by Lloyd Bell, who was a member of the Club from 1957-1976. This Plate was fully engraved and in 2003 a new one was purchased by the Club. Pairs play separately and their four-ball scores are added together to determine the winner

TARTAN CHALLENGE

Trophy donated by long-time course marshall, Gerry Devitt for annual competition in a Team Scramble format. First played in 2011.



WEEKEND WOMEN'S TRAY
(Formerly Business Girls Tray)

Tray donated by Vesta & Jack Trobe in 1969. Vesta Trobe was Women's Captain in 1965-66. Thirty-six holes aggregate stroke (net) played over two consecutive Saturdays for competition by weekend women. On the eve of the 1976 competition the trophy was placed in the Long Pocket safe which was blown up by burglars during the night. The tray was repaired but still bears some evidence of its mistreatment.

Original tray was fully engraved and replaced in 2016 with a new tray donated by long term weekend player, Jocelyn Dixon. Jocelyn joined Indooroopilly in 1958.

VO WALKER TROPHY

Cup donated by the family of the late VO Walker in 2002 for 36 holes aggregate stroke (net) competition. The trophy is a PGA Championship Cup won by Ossie Walker, who was our Club professional from 1937-71. For many years prior to the donation of the perpetual trophy, the event was played for a prize donated firstly by Ossie's successor, Rob Gibson, and later by the golf shop.

Plate donated in 1993 by Dorothy Sharpe, who joined the Club in 1953 and was a member for 50 years. 36 holes aggregate net stroke, age specific event.

ANNE BOURNE CUP



Anne Bourne was a much-loved member of the weekend women's group from 1966 until her death in 2021. Her family donated the trophy for competition between weekend women over the Summer break. The player with the best aggregate of three single stableford scores in any women's Saturday competition during that period wins the event.

Anne had a rich professional, cultural and sporting life. She was a respected statistician and an avid traveller with a keen interest in history. There were not many places in the world Anne had not visited – it is thought she had been to every country whose name ended in "stan".

The trophy is an excellent challenge over the Summer season and an appropriate tribute to Anne who considered golf should be played in all weathers – rain, wind, floods and searing heat being mere bagatelles.

HAZEL FADDEN MEMORIAL TROPHY

Trophy donated in 2004 by the family of the late Hazel Fadden (Women's President 1980-82 and Women's Captain 1974-75). The original competition for the best net score on any course during the year ceased in 2014. The trophy was reinstated in 2018 and is now awarded to the player having the best aggregate net score for six rounds of the monthly medal.



INDOOROOPILLY BOWL

Trophy donated in 1989 by the late Elaine Maxwell (Women's Captain 1986-88). Best gross score on any course during the year. The trophy was originally presented for best gross score on Indooroopilly Open Day, the first winner being Rachel Hetherington (Club Champion in 1993).
