The Junior Age Championship, open to all members who have not yet reached the age of 18 (on Saturday 31 May 2025), will see male and female Juniors compete head-to-head against each other to win the Eckett/Muller Cup

Qualifying

Qualifying based on 18 holes stableford (Males off blue tees and Females off red tees)

• Junior Age qualifying round will be held in conjunction with the Junior Girls Championships (Gross)

The top 8 stableford scores to qualify to play **handicap Match Play for the Eckett/Muller Cup.** Qualifying ties for 8th place will be decided by count back.

Members wishing to qualify:

- Players must register in the golf shop by signing the registration sheet at check in to indicate your intention to play in the Junior Age Championships
- Players are reminded that if they register, they must be available to play on each of the nominated Match Play dates.

*Note: No registration means you are unavailable!

Match Play

• 18-hole matches played on the following dates:

Quarter Finals Sunday 8 June Semi Finals Saturday 14 June Finals Sunday 15 June

- Male Juniors to play off the Blue tees, Female Juniors play off the Red tees.
- Daily Handicap on the day of play applies. The player with the higher Daily Handicap receives shots from the other player based on the full difference in Daily Handicap using the Match Play Index

Forfeits

Once the Match Play draw has been determined it is not expected there will be any withdrawals. However, it can happen that a member who has qualified is unable to play for health, injury or other legitimate/acceptable reasons. The following protocols will apply in the event of a withdrawal:

<u>Withdrawal</u>
before the
quarter finals

Golf Operations will take reasonable steps to contact the highest ranked reserve in qualifiers from that age group (i.e. qualifiers 9 onwards) and offer that person the vacated spot without otherwise adjusting the draws.

The first person offered who confirms acceptance will be given the spot.

As there will be no adjustment of the draw, this means that a person ranked 9^{th} or 10^{th} could end up filling the #1 seed position..

The first person offered who confirms acceptance will be given the spot.

Withdrawal after Quarter Finals

The highest ranked loser within that group from the just-completed round will be offered the spot.

Golf Operations will take reasonable steps to contact the highest ranked loser and offer that person the vacated spot. The first person offered who confirms acceptance will be given the spot.

This means that someone who moves to the next round could end up playing the person they defeated in a previous round.
