Members wishing to qualify:

Members entering the tournament **must** fill out the online entry form via the email link sent to you or via the post online, or fill out a paper version in the Golf Shop and put into the entry box in the Golf Shop no later than <u>6:00pm on Wednesday 24</u> <u>September 2025</u>.

Players have the option of choosing what day they play their first 2 rounds.

Players must nominate on the entry form whether they want to play on either the Saturday or Tuesday for their first round. (Saturday 4 October or Tuesday 7 October)

For the second round, you have the same option of playing either the Saturday or the Tuesday (Saturday 11 October or Tuesday 14 October)

Golf Operations will enter all players for the first 2 rounds after entries close. Players will be drawn with similar handicapped players, with changes not permitted without Golf Operations consent.

Events to be contested by your GA handicap

(54 Holes Gross Stroke Play):

| Event | GA handicap eligibility (as of your first round) |

| Championship grade | 10.9 and under |
| A grade | 11.0 to 20 |
| B-grade | 20.1 to 30 |
| C-grade | 30.1 and above |

Tournament format

- 54 Holes gross stroke play with a 36 hole cut for the last round.
- There will be a seeded draw for the last round
- The top 8 players plus ties and any player with in 10 shots of the lead player in Championship grade, A grade, B grade and C grades to make the final round after 36 hole cut off.
- Your grade will be determined on your 1st round
- After 54 holes, all ties for first place in any grade, the winner will be decided by a sudden death playoff straight after the 3rd round is completed.
- Entry fee will be the normal \$12 competition fee for each round (plus member guest green fee as applicable for certain membership categories if playing on a day their membership doesn't normally allow).

Eligibility

A member's membership category must include eligibility to play in Club Stroke Play Championships (Honour Board Events) and you must be available for all dates. To be eligible to play for any of the events, members must have a minimum of 20 legitimate scorecard entries in their Golf Link record and their handicap must not be designated as "Provisional".
