54 Holes Gross Stroke Play

- **2nd Round** Sunday 12 October
- **Final Round** Sunday 19 October

Events to be contested (54 Holes Gross Stroke Play):

Event	GA handicap and Age eligibility (as of Saturday 11 Oct)	Tee Markers
Championship grade	6.0 and under	Black Tees
A grade	6.1 to 11.0	Blue Tees
B grade	11.1 to 20.0	Blue Tees
C grade	20.1 and above	Blue Tees
Juniors	Age under 18	Blue Tees
Seniors	Age 55 to 64	Blue Tees
Veterans	Age 65 and over	Blue Tees

Members wishing to enter the tournament **must** fill out the online entry form via the email link sent to you or via the post online, or fill out a paper version in the Golf Shop and put it into the entry box in the Golf Shop no later than **6:00pm on Wednesday 1 October 2025.**

IMPORTANT: If your GA handicap is 6.0 or better on Saturday 11 October, you will be in the Championship grade off the Black tees. If you are eligible for an Age category as well (Jnr, Snr or Vet), then you can opt out of the Championship grade event and play only in the Age category off the Blue tees. You MUST mark this on the entry form.

** Optional - If wanting to play in the Championship grade and have NOT opted out on to the Blue tees in an age category specifically, you will still be eligible for the Age categories, but keep in mind you will be competing against others that will be off the Blue markers.*

All grades and Age categories will be determined on date of 1st round.

The first 2 rounds you will be drawn in the grade or age category you have selected or eligible for as best we can. If we have more numbers that can't fit on one course, then events will be distributed across both courses fairly on the day and will be reversed for the 2nd round. Golf Operations will do this after entries close with no changes permitted once completed. **There will be a seeded draw for the last round after the 36 hole cut to top 8 and ties and any player with in 10 shots of the lead player.**

NO late entries will be accepted

Tournament format

- 54 Holes gross stroke play with a 36 hole cut off for the last round
- All competitors will and must play both courses in the first 2 rounds
- The top 8 players plus ties and any player with in 10 shots of the lead player in Championship grade, A grade, B grade, C grade, Juniors, Seniors and Veterans to make the final round after 36 hole cut off
- After 54 holes, all ties for first place in any grade/age category, the winner will be decided by a sudden death playoff straight after the 3rd round is completed.

Entry details

- Entries will be collated by Golf Operations after entries close:
 - Entrants will be assigned a tee-off time by Golf Operations for both the 1st and 2nd rounds.
 - Entry fee will be the normal \$12 competition fee for each round (plus member guest green fee as applicable for certain membership categories).
 - Entrants will be grouped into AM and PM fields. If possible, entrants will be assigned to AM or PM fields in accordance with the preference indicated on their entry form, but this will depend on the number of entries and cannot be guaranteed.
 - If entries exceed capacity, the higher GA handicaps in each grade or age category at the time entries close, will be balloted out and will be put on a reserve list.
 - *The time sheets for Saturday 11 October (Monthly medal) will open as per normal at 6:00am eight days in advance for Members who are not entering the Club Stroke play Championships. Members can book online in the normal manner, using any possible vacant AM/PM spots on the booking sheet for these days.*

Eligibility

A member's membership category must include eligibility to play in Club Stroke Play Championships (Honour Board Events) and you must be available for all dates. To be eligible to play in any of these events, members must have a minimum of 20 legitimate scorecard entries in their Golf Link record and their handicap must not be designated as "Provisional".
