MONDAY 4 MAY 2026

Event 1: Barbara Parsons Trophy - \$55 per player

- # 18 holes Stableford (draw in handicap order)
- # 70 years & over.
- # Golf Australia handicap limit 31.1 on date of play
- # Presentation to be made at the end of the day

Event 2: Jeanne Heweston Trophy - \$35 per player

- # 9 holes Stableford. Holes 1-9 (draw in handicap order)
- # 70 years & over.
- # Golf Australia handicap limit 54.0 on date of play
- # Presentation to be made at the end of the day

Event 5: The Marrum Cup - \$270 per team

- # Team event (one team per club and all 3 players must be from the same club)
- # 18 hole stroke handicap
- # Golf Australia handicap limit 21.8 on date of play
- # Prizes awarded to the top 3 teams
- # Each team member is automatically entered in all eligible events on the day; Captain's Cup, Associates' Cup, Professionals' Trophy and Cecily Lascelles Cup (if playing on Tuesday).
- # Clubs may indicate their preference for an 8:00am or 1:00pm shotgun start; however, preference cannot be guaranteed
- # Presentations to be made as soon as possible after the event

Breakfast: Available in the Clubhouse.

Lunch: Sandwiches & light meals available in the Clubhouse daily. (Sandwiches available from 10.00am)

Dinner: A la carte dinner is available in the Clubhouse each night.

Accommodation: There are 19 ensuite guest rooms available in the Clubhouse.

Dress code: The club has a dress code. Members and visitors are expected to dress in a manner in keeping with the club's standards, traditions and welcoming environment.
Dress code on the course: Neat attire includes a collared shirt/polo, tailored trousers/shorts/skirt and soft spike golf shoes. These are the minimum requirements. See the website www.barwonheads.golf for more details
Dress code in the clubhouse: In most areas, smart golfing attire suitable for the course is also suitable in the clubhouse. Denim is not allowed on the course or in the clubhouse.

Conditions

1. Entry fees must be paid at time of entry.
2. The Women's Captain, Vice-Captain, Director of Golf and Golf Operations Coordinator will make all arrangements and have full power to alter or to make any variation in the programme should they deem it necessary or desirable. They may in the event of bad weather, or for any reason shorten, alter or cancel the contest. They have the power to limit the number of entries and reserve the right to return entries once the field has reached capacity.
3. Each event has a Golf Australia handicap limit associated with it. Entries will not be accepted from players who sit outside the handicap limit for each event.
4. No refunds after the draw is published unless a medical certificate is provided. Substitutions may be made prior to the commencement of the event.
5. The competition shall be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as are adopted by the R & A Rules Limited, Scotland, together with such local rules as are in force on the course over which the competition takes place. If a dispute should arise on any point, it shall be decided by the Committee in charge of the competition, whose decision shall be final. The Committee, if in doubt, shall have the right to refer any such dispute to Golf Australia, whose decision shall then be final.
6. The events are open to women members of Clubs registered with Golf Australia.
7. All ties will be decided by count-back, as recommended by Golf Australia.
8. Golf Carts – The use of motorised golf carts on the course is regulated in detail in the club by-laws. In club competition rounds motorized carts may only be used with the permission of the Committee and only for medical reasons. A medical certificate must be presented. Golfers may only use motorized golf carts supplied by Barwon Heads Golf Club. When two players in a group require a cart, these players must share a cart if requested to do so.
